

McGrady Insurance Motorsport UK NI Rally Championship 2021 Competitor Bulletin No 1 17/6/2021

COVID 19

Due to the ongoing COVID19 Pandemic, many aspects of the events will have changed to comply with Motorsport UK / Local Government Regulations, it is essential that competitors and their crew follow all the protocols set out by the clubs, failure to do so may be penalised as per Article 6.1

6.1 Should any car be found to be ineligible for the class entered on any Championship event, or if any competitor is excluded from the Championship or a Championship event for fraudulent or unsportsmanlike behaviour, or bringing the sport into disrepute, all points scored by both crew members to date may be forfeited. Additionally, any registered competitor who brings the sport into disrepute through the un-authorised use of private and/or Forest Service lands will result in the forfeiture of any points awarded (to-date) and the annulment of their registration for this championship.

ELIGIBILITY

As per Article 5.15 The onus is on every competitor to ensure that they are entered each championship event in the correct class.

With the self declaration and only a small percentage of cars to be physically scrutineered on the day, it is essential you are in the correct class, if you are unsure please speak to either the Championship Eligibility Scrutineer or the Event Scrutineers and if required contact the Competition Secretary and have your class amended before the event starts. Random eligibility checks may take place throughout the event.

As per Article 5.8 All cars must comply with the current Motorsport UK vehicle regulations (including the requirement for all vehicles to produce a logbook) appropriate to the individual event entered.

To assist with the random eligibility checks we recommend that vehicle logbooks / vehicle passports are carried within the competition car at all times so they are available when requested.
